- 1. Walk-Trot (12 years & Under) Pleasure Class

**RULE: Walk-Trot may NOT cross enter into any classes that canter or jump

- 7. Hunter Hack Jr. & AA.....2 jumps at 18”
- 8. Hunter Hack Open.....2 jumps at 18”
- 9. Cross Rails Hunters – Beginner Rider or Horse.....18”
- 10. Cross Rails Hunters – Beginner Rider or Horse.....18”
- 11. Cross Rails Hunters – Jr. & AA Equitation O/F over course.....18”
- 12. Cross Rails Hunters – Under Saddle (Jr. & A/A)
- 13. Cross Rails Hunters – Equitation Flat (Jr. & A/A)

**RULE: Cross Rails Jr. & Adult Rider & Beginner Rider shall NOT
cross enter into any class higher than 2’3”
Champion and Reserve for Classes 9 thru 13**

- 14. Warm up Hunters-Open.....2’0”
- 15. Pony Hunter: Open to all pony’s, not exceeding 14.2.....2’0”
- 16. Pony Hunter: Open to all pony’s, not exceeding 14.2.....2’0”
- 17. Pony Hunter Under Saddle

Table II Sec. 2(b) – Time first jump-off. Jump off for clean rounds. Rider stays in the ring and upon audible signal, jumps course designed for Jump-Off. If there are no clean rounds and there is a tie, a Jump-Off will decide the winner (time will decide in case riders have equal faults in the Jump-Off)

Table II, Sec. 3(c) – Time first jump-off. Jump off for clean rounds. Rider stays in the ring and after crossing finish line, proceeds to jump course designed for Jump-Off. Time starts for Jump-Off course when horse crosses finish line of first course.

CLASS SPECIFICATIONS

- **Ages (defined):** Children & Juniors – 17 years and under.
- **Walk-Trot:** Riders may NOT cross enter into any other division.
- **Hunter Hack:** Open to Junior A/A and Open. The use of martingales is prohibited in this class.
- **Cross Rail Hunters:** May trot or canter. Riders may NOT cross-enter into any classes that jump higher than 2’3”.
- **Low Children’s/AA Hunters:** Open to junior and adult amateur riders. No oxers.
- **Jumpers:** Open to ALL riders.
- **Pony Riders:** 17 years and under
- **O.F.:** Means “Over Fences”
- **A/A:** Means “Adult Amateur”
- **Beverly Kruglick Medal Class:** 8 Fences, 2 Rounds. Top 4 called back for flat work. Medal to 1st and Ribbons to 6th. One time winner per year. 2nd through 6th place may enter until they win.
